

Program Champion (PC) Role Descriptions & Fee Structure

Program Champions are independent contractors that rely on their professional experience and fitness knowledge to support Tivity Health within the designated territory. Support could include event coverage, instructor development, and ongoing SilverSneakers brand awareness. Champions are recruited based on their credentials, certifications and/or academic qualifications, and experience. Failure to maintain current credentials will result in revocation of the contract, which will be reviewed on an annual basis.

- Current with all SilverSneakers teaching criteria (Foundations, Fraud, Waste and Abuse, and other formatspecific training as needed)
- Hold a relevant national certification through ACE, AFAA, NASM, or ACSM
- Current CPR certification
- Liability insurance
- Minimum two (2) years teaching SilverSneakers and/or management experience preferred
- High degree of computer literacy (MS Office Products)
- Internet/email access
- Strong organizational skills
- Strong instructional skills
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to function independently with little supervision
- Ability to cover events 1 10 times a month in assigned territory (limited overnight)
- Bilingual positions available. Proficiency in Spanish is highly desirable.

Position Summary - 3 Roles:

PC - Presenter (this is a future role that is not being filled at this time)

- Performs all the functions of the Instructor Leader and Event Assistant
- Facilitate choreography exchanges with instructors in territory
- · Provide mentoring to Instructors as needed

PC - Instructor Leader

- Performs all the functions of the Event Assistant
- Teach event demos
- Lead pop-up classes
- Assist at in-person continuing education trainings
- Class site visits when needed (Participating Location and FLEX)
- Perform instructor evaluations (future work TBD)

PC – Event Assistant (based on high-need areas without Leader candidates)

- Work with health plans and community organizations to represent SilverSneakers with the utmost knowledge, professionalism and integrity
- Provide table/booth support at various events
- Lead event speaking presentations for various initiatives
- Maintain communication records and accurate reports regarding expenses
- Track and report event feedback and attendance metrics

Reimbursable Miscellaneous Expense Guidelines/Examples:

- · Examples: Parking, tolls, subways, trains, ferries, occasional purchases as requested by Tivity Health
- \cdot All expenses must be pre-approved in writing by Tivity Health prior to incurrence

Travel Time Fee/Guidelines:

- · In addition to the hourly rate for the Services, you will be compensated for travel time in accordance with the following zones:
 - Zone 1 = If you live 1 30 miles from event/venue, add 1 hour to event coverage time
 - Zone 2 = If you live 31 75 miles from event/venue, add 1.5 hours to event coverage time
 - Zone 3 = If you live over 75 miles from event/venue, add 2 hours to event coverage time
- Example: You live 15 miles from an event/venue. The event is from 11 am 2 pm so you will arrive at 10:30 am. You will be paid for 3.5 hours plus an additional 1 hour based on Zone 1 above, which equals 4.5 hours total.
 - · If you live > 100 miles from event/venue, this must be pre-approved by Tivity Health as this could result in an overnight stay.
